"It went really well although it was a challenge," she said.

"On the Saturday, we had 30

homeless extras on set but they all really enjoyed it. A lot said it had really helped them and they want to get involved again. Derek was committed, he learned his lines and turned up every single day. He came here to try to change his luck and to be acting alongside Dave Spikey was great for him."
